Player	Wear ingame clothes during the game and show consideration for others' immersion (e.g. avoid offgame talk in public and empty cans of beer in camp).	Respect location. Follow fire safety guidelines. Do not vandalize, do not litter. If something breaks let us know.
	Read and follow the simple version of the rules and count your hits fairly.	Read all the material in the participants letter.
	Support your unit leader and the rest of the military hierarchy in making the battle game work.	Treat your co-players with consideration, care and respect. Respect other peoples' boundaries. Seek consent actively if you are lucky enough to find you in a situation where this is relevant.
	Do not larp sexual violence.	Show respect for significant danish law.
	Use the military hierarchy to resolve issues with the battle game play, i.e. "they strike too hard" or "they dont count their hits". NOT ingame larp conflicts and NOT offgame conflicts not related to the battle game play.	Treat the volunteers and the NPCs with respect and be helpful. Do not complain about the Larp to the volunteers, but take it up with the organizers. One exception is of course the safety hosts.
	Do not play on discrimination that builds on things people cannot change offgame, i.e. skin colour or gender. Do play on prejudices about ingame religions, provinces and class differences.	If a problem negatively affects your game experience, and the organizers are able to do something about it (i.e. toilets, food etc), then let us know asap during the game.
		Show up on time and do not leave without getting your camp area approved and helping out with the general cleanup.
		If anyone is seriously hurt, call 112, then inform the organizers.
		Follow the instructions of the volunteers and organizers and let us know if there is an issue with doing this.

	Put the players' experience above your own and follow the specific expectations set out between you and the organizers. For organizers specifically; the expectations agreed upon with each other and with the board of Rollespilsfabrikken.
